
## DIGITAL ENTREPRENEURSHIP DEFINITIONS



E-entrepreneurship refers to establishing a new company with an innovative business idea within the net economy, which, using an electronic platform in data networks, offers its products and/or services based upon a purely electronic creation of value.

Essential is the fact that this value offer was only made possible through the development of information technology.

"Digital Entrepreneurship is the combination of digital infrastructure and entrepreneurial agents within the context of both ecosystems."



## How do I become a digital entrepreneur?

An online advice website set up by a serial entrepreneur, suggests 11 simple steps to get your new idea off the ground. It's worth noting, however, that not all of these steps may be applicable to a digital entrepreneur.

- 1. Come up with a business idea
- 2. Research your idea
- 3. Create your business plan
- 4. Choose your business structure
- 5. Get funding (may not be needed if a purely digital service)
- 6. Register your business (may not be needed but best to check)
- 7. Set up shop
- 8. Build your team (or go solo as many digital entrepreneurs do)
- 9. Choose your suppliers (if needed, such as choosing your e-commerce, CRM systems or blogging platforms
- 10. Launch your business
- 11. Grow your business





## What are the key characteristics needed to be a digital entrepreneur?

The digital entrepreneurs who succeed share specific skills and traits, which include:

- Digital skills: You may need to set up a website, manage online sales or social media.
- Creativity: All entrepreneurs use their creativity to come up with an idea in the first place and then problems, often with limited resources.
- Adaptability: Digital technology is changing all the time, which means your potential markets and marketing strategies will need to adapt and change too.
- Leadership: Having the confidence to make informed decisions is important whether you operate alone and even more so if you are managing a team.
- Networking: Whether you are communicating with customers, suppliers or promotional outlets, building relationships and raising awareness of your business venture is critical.

## Turkey





Virtual entrepreneurship (aka digital entrepreneurship or online entrepreneurship) in Türkiye has gained significant momentum in the last 10 years. Especially with the acceleration of digitalization after the pandemic, many virtual enterprises have emerged in areas such as e-commerce, digital content production, online education, software-based solutions and commerce via social media.

#### 1. Trendyol

Originally established as a virtual fashion enterprise, it is currently one of the largest e-commerce platforms in Turkey. Founder: Demet Mutlu.

It became a "unicorn" by receiving investment from Alibaba in 2021.

### 2. Yemeksepeti

Founded in 2001, one of Turkey's first online food ordering platforms.

Founder: Nevzat Aydın.

Acquired by Delivery Hero in 2015.

#### 3. Getir

A mobile market application born with the idea of delivery in minutes.

Founder: Nazım Salur.

It has opened up to international markets and has become a "unicorn".



4. Udemy (Turkish founder, headquartered in the USA)
A global platform operating in the field of educational technologies.

One of its founders: Eren Bali (born in Malatya). Users can create online courses and earn income.

5. Culinary Arts Workshops - Startups on Instagram/YouTube

There are many individual entrepreneurs who cook and sell at home, provide recipe training or promote products.

They are usually run by women and work with the "home entrepreneurship" model.

For example: "Refika's Kitchen" YouTube channel.

6. Individual Entrepreneurs on Letgo / Dolap / Gardrops Especially young people and women earn income by selling second-hand or handmade products.

Due to such applications, the number of "micro entrepreneurs" is increasing.

7. Social Media Phenomenons and Influencer Entrepreneurship

People with a large number of followers are entrepreneurs by selling products, receiving advertisements or offering digital products.

For example: There are many examples in areas such as makeup, fashion, personal development, and healthy living.

8. Virtual Education and Consultancy Platforms Instructors, coaches and consultants provide online services via Zoom, Udemy, and Google Meet.

For example: Career coaching, language training, and carbon footprint consultancy.






